

I turned her on to this. I was constantly bin diving for 12" singles and making mixtapes, and from 1983 - past her WHIDTDT recording with the PSB's, I would turn her on to things. More speciically, songs that she would get a kick out of (I loved making her laugh), that would inspire her, and every single artist in that new brit invasion that was inspired by HER, I made sure she heard, and read their interviews...and what they had to say about her. Oh yes. I have all my records and all the mixtapes, still to this day.

Dusty was very up on everything, in her so called "lost" years - inspite of the fact that she really was burnt out on the business. You know, music's one thing - the peeps in the biz are another.

Besides Wendy and Lisa - she LOVED Prince....had high marks for Adam Ant (Simon I believe was singing with him at one point, too), I used to nag her about doing something with Daryl Hall....turned her on to Boy George, Thomas Dolby, and absolutely loads of others.

PSB's in my opinion, simply got lucky....and only cos they were really persistent. It took a few years for them to finally get her to agree.

Seriously. If it had been Prince that had called, she would have LEAPT at the chance.

The "Lost" years will eventually all be told.

And, they aren't to be confused with the tabloid drivel that has been shoveled out.

She didn't know the PSB's, and the deciding factor for doing WHDTDT was that she wouldn't be responsible for carrying the single. It would be on their LP and up to them to promote, et al. It was Allee Willis, who besides co-writing the song, got it to Dusty. Dusty was a friend of Allee's, and she did a few of her songs - both before and after WHDTDT.

In otherwords, they were never on her want-to-work-with dream sheet. Ever.

But, it worked out, and she was grateful and gracious to them.

Hey Teda

Allee Willis wrote a song with David Lasley "I WISH THAT LOVE WOULD LAST" 1980. Look it up, it's on Disc 4 of Simply Dusty. It was the B-side to IT GOES LIKE GOES from NORMA RAE which DUSTY recorded for 20th Century Fox. It was released in JULY of 1980.

Got that?

That's good cos there is more....

Allee co-wrote WHIDTDT with the PSB's, with Dusty in mind. Allee was friends with Dusty and Vicki, Dusty had already recorded IWTLWL, so it was ALLEE who was able to find DUSTY and get the song to her.

This is all very well documented.

WHIDTDT wouldn't have happened for Dusty at all - if not for Allee. Allee came up with the parts that Dusty sang, and Dusty sang them just as Allee had laid them down in the demo. The PSB's were never friends of Dusty's, Dusty wasn't hanging out in gay mens clubs in LA where she would have heard them, and.....they didn't have any idea how to reach her.

They were fans.

Which is great cos they championed her and the song....and, did the promotion for it.

You can say whatever you want....Teda

Whatever you say is only a reflection of your world.

But the realities about how things happened - belong to MANY people, and there are many facts that just don't jive with your version.

Sorry.

The 3rd song Dusty did, and it was her favorite song on all of REPUTATION was SEND IT TO ME, which Allee wrote with LAUREN WOOD.
