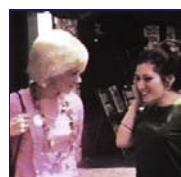

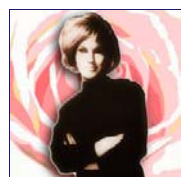

Cas, the flower fund was begun almost a couple of years ago, before DDO6. My memory is that Laura and I did a lot of it...collecting money and selling lil Dusty bracelets.
