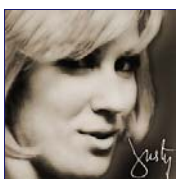

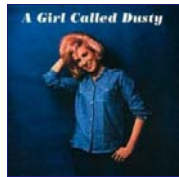

I've resurrected this thread because tonight I have been reminded (as if I needed reminding) of what The Voice can do for me when I'm feeling low.

I have been knocked sideways by the news of Michael Jackson's death. His music has always been of great significance in my life, and his loss, just weeks before I was finally to see him live after the disappointment of a cancelled show in the 90s, has really, really got to me.

My inability to tear myself away from the rolling news coverage has meant that - almost unprecedentedly - I have not listened to Dusty for 48 hours. This is just about unheard of; I generally play at least a song or two of hers every day.

Unable to shake off the blues, I put on the 'Full Circle' DVD a little while ago, hoping that this would at least deter me from playing 'One Day In Your Life' yet again.

I watched that stupendous live version of 'You Don't Have To Say You Love Me', and a strange and rather beautiful thing happened.

I have always known that her voice has some kind of profound, mystical effect on me that I can't fully pin down or articulate. But just listening to her in all her full-throated, belting, beautiful honey-coated glory this evening just made my spine tingle, and my spirits soar, and my heart race, just as though I was hearing her for the first time. Quite simply, she made me feel much better in the time it took her to sing the first line.

So on a very strange, sad, other-worldly evening, I have been reminded just why Dusty is so important to me, and why I love her so much.

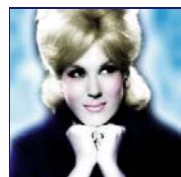

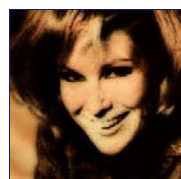

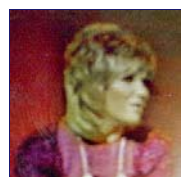
