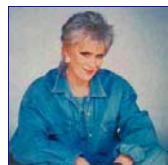

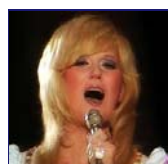

Although I'd been lucky enough to have a sneak preview of the DVD, I sat and watched the proper one through tonight, having just got back from hols. I love having the Poll Concert footage in full on the bonus cuts, all seamed together in their correct order, just like two mini little concerts. We have to be really grateful that these clips survived as the only true live concert footage from the 60's. Dusty on stage didn't perform like she did in the studio, the performances aren't perfect but that's what made them special. There's an energy, you can't take your eyes off her, they make me smile, she makes me smile. And as for All Cried Out, well, the stars were aligned that night and she is perfect. I have enjoyed the DVD, the only thing for me that spoils it is the inclusion of so much from Bandstand. Not because I don't enjoy that show, it was of it's time and showed a lot of Dusty's many faces (or at least hairstyles!), but because I think the mimeing is off and it doesn't work well alongside the brilliant live performances. The video footage of Dusty leaving planes is a bonus that I would love to see more of. I don't know where it came from, news reports at the time maybe, but I wish we could see more of them, they're rare and rare is always good 😊 I also liked what they did with the closing credits to I'm Gonna Leave You, lots of interesting pics, sleeves and clippings to look at. Same goes for the booklet. Great liner notes from Annie and some new pictures to boot. And a nice little touch to make the photos look like they have the sellotape on them!

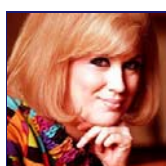

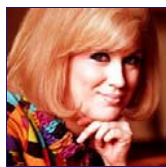

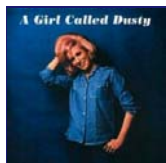
