The worst is over here in NYC. I live just blocks from the East River and just one block from a mandatory evacuation zone. We hunkered down and due to past experience stocked up on food and water and made sure we had enough batteries for flashlights and such. Irene began to break up after it hit NJ early this morning. It has down been downgraded to a tropical storm and the rain has ceased in NYC. Yes, many areas around and in the city are suffering from flooding, but much of that was anticipated due to their location near to the shore or rivers. We got almost 6 inches of rain, which added to the unusual amount of rainfall already received, this the wettest August on record and the wettest summer ever. A lot of downed power lines in many areas. Some roadways are closed and later today they will begin to assess the situation in the subway and train tunnels.

But, us native New Yorkers are a resilient bunch. This wasn't our first hurricane and we've lived through blizzards, nor'easters, and of course, our biggest disaster, 9/11. The local governments and media did a fine job of warning people on what to expect and how to prepare.

The city was a ghost town last night. No one was out and about. No cars and almost every store closed in the afternoon before the storm hit.

This will all be a memory in the next few days...
