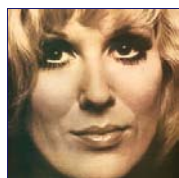
If only I could understand and appreciate everything (men, money, my tax return) like I do Dusty, my life would be a lot easier. Although possibly a lot more dull!
