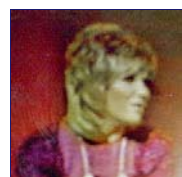

I thought so too. Perhaps because sexual orientation and gay marriage are such current issues, when D's sexuality comes up in an interview, it tends to overshadow everything else. If, as a society, we were not so preoccupied with it, it probably wouldn't have that effect.

The tortured soul part of it is, of course, on target too. It's not just the sexuality but the awful choices that D was forced into as a result of having to conceal it. And that's a compelling part of D's story too.

It is remarkable how the tone was completely different, though, when focused on the music and stage persona.

I was just reading Josh's post on the Gay Marriage thread and it seems so similar to D's situation, still today, in 2009.
