

I would love to say that I did this with Dusty however I never did. I spent hours and hours going through records with Dusty finding things that she liked and didn't like. Some she used on stage with The Echoes others for television/Radio shows and others songs she wanted to record sometime. There were songs she liked that were later hits for her and others that were hits but not by her. She really could pick great songs. Dusty used lots of arrangers for her records which would have depended on what style of song it was. "Mixed up Girl" was arranged by Peter Knight who did many things for Dusty produced of course by Johnny Franz. Peter Knight also did" What are you doing for the rest of your life", "Yesterday when I was Young" and others for Dusty as well as things for The Walker Brothers and The Moody Blues. A very talented musician. No I never played bass on this track. When I moved to Australia I did do an arrangement and played on a version of this song that I did for a very good New Zealand girl singer called Allison Durbin. Allison was living in Melbourne and one of the top female singers at the time. Did many arrangements for her over a number of years. She would have been very successful had she had gone to England as against Australia in 1969. That's the way the cookie crumbles. I did play Dusty some of her recordings who thought she was really good.


