DUSTY

Born in West Hampstead, London, on April 16th, 1940, of Irish/Scottlish parents, this girl called Dusty seems to have been destined for the world of popular music from the word 'go'. Although to-day one of the world's top recording stars, it is interesting to recall that her first recording effort took place in a corner of the Springfields family kitchen. Brother Tom, who was later to become the founder member of The Springfields, was planist, guitarist and A & R man, whilst sister Dusty provided sounds of somewhat varying musical quality by 'playing' a twisted copper frying pan, a cracked, secondhand pair of maraccas and an old cigar box filled with marbles—well everyone has to start somewhere!

With a brother so mad about music it wasn't long before Dusty caught the musical bug too and before very long had formed her own vocal group at the convent school she attended. This group however, whilst appreciated by many within the convent walls, was brought to a sudden and unhappy end by the geography mistress who banned them from the school concert as she felt that their use of deep purple lighting during a hip version of 'St. Louis Blues' had an erotic effect.

Soon school days were behind her and with Tom's encouragement Dusty took up the guitar and obtained of ployment at a small club in the evenings, at old and playing folk and Latin-American numbers, whilst by day she

This episode made Dusty realize that maybe she wasn't really qualified to be a sales girl and she decided to follow Tom's lead and enter show business full time. Answering a trade press advertisement she became one of the Lana Sisters and made her TV debut as part of this trio in 1958 on '6.5 Special'. Being part of this group gave her invaluable experience so that when, in the Summer of 1960, Tom suggested she join him and a friend, Tim Feild, in forming a vocal trio she jumped at the chance and thus the famous Springfields were born. The Springfields story is already too well known to warrant repeating but suffice to say that as a group they made show business history and when in September, 1963, they mutually agreed to split up and go their own separate ways, it made headline news.

Dusty's first single 'I Only Want To Be With You' was issued on November 8th and immediately made the Hit Parade. At this time of writing it has become a world hit, being at the moment No. 12 in the American charts and on countless hit parades throughout the world.

Directly after cutting this disc, Dusty started on this, her first LP, and to show the versatility of this tremendously talented artist, the songs contained herein run the whole gamut of 'pop' music to-day, from the very exciting wild tracks like 'Don't You Know' to the beautiful balled treatments of 'Anyone Who Had A Heart' and


