O.K. It's high time I came clean here - I liked this DVD, despite what John Aizlewood of Q Magazine said. In last July's Bulletin, he really panned this DVD, giving it 1 star out of 5. When I saw the You Tube clip of You Don't Have To Say You Love Me, (the best part of the concert), I bought the disc. So, it's not one of the all time greats, but it's not as bad as he says. He says that most of her classics are in a medley that was under-rehearsed. Fair enough - In the interview section of the DVD, Simon Bell says that they didn't have much time to rehearse, so take this into account. And Dusty seems to be having a great time - Running around the stage, laughing and talking to the crowd. My only disappointment was my Dusty favorite, I Only Want To Be With You (the song I heard first as a kid that made me her fan to begin with). It was part of a medley, and she gave it too short a shrift - I would liked to have heard it in it's entirety. Aizlewood also says that Dusty's rendition of We Are Family was "toe-curling". This goes to something else that Dusty does for me - Her ability to take a song I don't like and make it sound good. I never liked that song - We Are Family, but I thought that Dusty's version here is pretty good. So there, Mr. Aizlewood - Stick that in your proverbial pipe and take a few puffs - See if I care! Hope at least a few of you agree with me here, if not it's O.K. - It can't be any worse than what this guy is trying to foist on us.


