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# Did Phillips make a mistake?

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
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#### <u>Did Phillips make a mistake ? (#p81855)</u>

Luckily it did get flipped in America and was a hit. I believe it was Dusty rather than Phillips who but the block on It's Over as a single, and maybe it was too gentle to be a hit, but then so was Goin' Back and that did pretty well. It deserves to be heard more now, but the fact that it wasn't ever a single stops it, and that's a shame as it's beautiful. 


