

Noel Harrison sang WOYM on The Thomas Crown Affair soundtrack & his version reached #8 in the UK after the song's Oscar win at the same time Dusty's version was hovering outside the US Top 30. It seems as if Philips UK wasn't very gung-ho about issuing Dusty's US recordings: it's hard to believe the Brits who purchased the version by Noel - who sings better than his pop but not much - wouldn't have opted for Dusty's version given the choice. It's curious Dusty had such a peripheral US hit with WOYM considering the promotional push that Jerry Wexler reportedly gave the track - that Dusty herself doesn't seem to have been enthused enough about WOYM to have personally given it much if any promo likely factored into the track falling short of its hit potential. And while I understand Dusty's fans preferring to hear her version it's not as if Macy's has had Eva Mendes cover a song which Dusty herself was in any evident way territorial about.


