When "What Have I Done To Deserve This" was originally released, I immediately fell in love with it and went out and bought the 12" single, the extended version; to this day, it remains one of my all-time favourites. But those were the 'dark years' and I didn't really know the first thing about Dusty other than she had been a big star in the Swinging Sixties. Years later, Fraser introduced me to Dusty properly and within a week (well it was actually only a couple of days but I wasn't telling him that!) 
