I posted this on inprivate and Nancy asked me to post this here too, so here is my impression, sorry if it is a bit late... This was great yesterc perhaps the nicest Dusty Day yet. Simon Bell ran a relaxed event with some good natured fun help from Madeline Bell, Kay Garner and a terrific player whose name I didn't get - but he was the "orchestra" as Madeline called him. Simon did a solo 30 mins act of Dusty songs which I caught end of, sadly as I went out for food at the wrong time, then Kay and Madeline each performed a set of Dusty songs ending on YDHTSYLM as Lesley Duncan could not attend but did send in a tape of her most famous song "Love Song" with her speaking in the middle about how much enjoyed working with Dusty and praising Simon for his efforts. I used to own her album and that song is really terrific - her piece de resistance forgot, also present was Riss? Chantelle and the second singer (whose name I forget entirely - sorry) from the Lana Sisters - they did not sin there, along with Julie Felix the folk singer (Going to the Zoo song - I think she collaborated with Tom perhaps on earlier efforts - anyone know

Pat Rhodes (Dusty's secretary) held a great auction which must have raised huge sums. Dusty's heated rollers were on sale and I was hoping bid but the price went soaring up to £400!! Three or 4 blouses each sold for £100 range each and her long pink dressing gown sold for £240 or thereabouts. 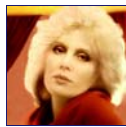
