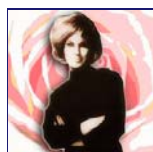

Still I was surprised to have won and when I went to collect it from Pat I found myself bursting into tears 😭 saying, you dont' know how much this means to me, and thank you for everything you do for Dusty. She told me 'stop it right now', and told me a bit about the scarf. She thinks it was from the 80s "when Dusty came back" and said she recalls her wearing it, around her neck, but also on her head, when they would bop into stores and such.

Last year I really enjoyed driving up bids on a number of items. Stephen beat me out for Fraser's complete set of The Dusty Springfield Bulletin, but I made him pay. 😊 I got lucky and won Fraser's copies of the new Simply Dusty earbook and CDs as well as his set of The Legend of Dusty Springfield (rare box set). 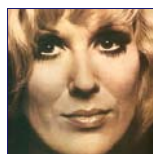

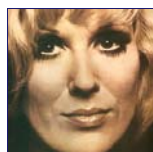

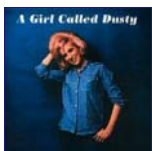
