BBC FOUR are repeating the 'Queens of British Pop' featuring Dusty, this Saturday evening at 20:00.

Followed by the 'Dusty' show with Tom Jones from 1967 at 22:05. As well as the songs which Dusty performs from the show which can be found on the 'Dusty at the BBC' dvd, this also includes 2 solo songs from Tom Jones as well as the excellent 'Baby Baby Baby' duet between Tom and Dusty.

Then at 22:30 they are showing an edition of 'Cilla' guest starring Dusty. I don't believe that this show has been seen on TV since it's original transmission in 1969. The official BBC FOUR website states that this is the episode in which Dusty and Cilla perform the duet 'Friendship'. The programme has a 50 minute time slot so should be shown in full, which means that (quick reference to 'The Complete Dusty') we should also be able to see Dusty perform live 'Ain't No Sun Since You've Been Gone' and 'Second Time Around'.

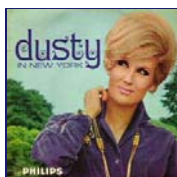

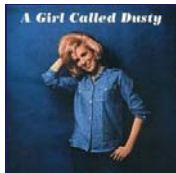

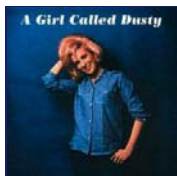
