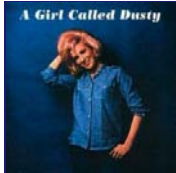

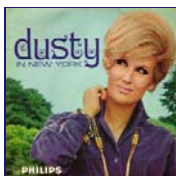

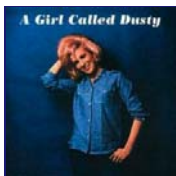
Gene Pitney had eleven top ten chart hits in the UK, mostly in the 1960s, but also achieving a No1 record with Marc Almond on a reworking of Something's Gotten Hold of My Heart in 1989. Twentyfour Hours From Tulsa reached No5 in December 1963, a month before Dusty recorded the song.
