As some of you may know, I've just been to San Remo, home of the Song Festival. In 1965, when Dusty performed there, she had a series taken and nobody has ever been sure just where they were taken. I think I always presumed they were in the grounds of the Casino where Festival took place. Wrong! I'd taken a couple of pictures of Dusty with me, just in case as we were wandering around, I could check later then having arrived on Thursday evening, I knew that was probably not going to be likely. I'd never seen so many gardens, round lights, pa similar looking buildings! But then next morning Jeremy decided to show the Dusty pictures to the lady on reception and as luck would have of the hotel was also there and she recognised where they were taken. And another lucky stroke, being as San Remo is a pretty big place, minutes up the hill behind our hotel. It was called The Savoy Hotel. I say was called, and the name is still on the building, but it's been completely renovated and the garden re-structured but it was obvious we'd found the right place. It's still not open and we couldn't get in, but did take pictures to compare with the '65 ones. Check out that strip of windows behind Dusty and you can see it in the new picture.

There is another picture of Dusty hugging a column in a row of columns, they are still there but have moved to the edge of the garden.

It actually felt really good to find the place and without any real effort too.

In '65 the Festival came from the Casino, a beautiful building only about 5 - 10 mins walk from the Savoy. In 1967 an Italian singer named L was appearing in the contest and failed to reach the final with his song (Dusty didn't make it either). He went back to his room in the Savo himself in the head. Luckily, Dusty didn't take her loss so much to heart. Apparently it was a big deal at the time as he left a note compla judges were basically, well let's say, not being fair!



These days the Festival is held at a rather drab looking theatre, that looks more like a cinema, called The Ariston. It must be a bit like the pictures I've seen of the auditorium inside bear no resemblance to the facade.




