The five albums released by Philips in the US between 1964 and 1967 were released on CD in the States in March 1999. Although MP3 downloads for all five have continued to be available, all five CDs were deleted from the catalogue some time ago, hence the large sums recently being asked for CD copies on Amazon Marketplace etc.

Two of those albums, ie Dusty and The Look of Love, were reissued on CD in the US on 28 January 2013. These are straight reissues of the 1999 CDs with the same bonus tracks. Here is a link to the Amazon US page:

The re-issues I have mentioned emanate from Universal in the US. I haven't heard about a re-issue programme by Universal UK. That said, of the albums issued during the 60s AGCD, ECUD, DD and DIM are all currently available in the UK on CD and as MP3 downloads. The exception is WAIG, which is only currently available as an MP3 download, unless you want to pay £33 to buy the CD from an Amazon Marketplace seller.

While the greatest hits compilations sell well, the sad fact is that sales of the original albums are pretty poor. In view of this, I can't imagine that there will be a re-issue of the original albums anytime soon.
