Hello, it's been a while since I last posted about her tree, but I think I may have some additional info. Dusty's paternal grandpa was Jeremiah Arthur E. O'Brien. He married Harriet May Merritt. Their children were Gerard A. O'Brien and Julia M. O'Brien.

I have info stating Dusty's mom, Catherine, died in 1974 and buried in Hampstead cemetery, but I'm not sure if this is correct. Gerard was born November 11, 1904 and died in December 1979.

This is the info I've found on Jeremiah. He was born in 1876 Sussex. Served in the Royal Sussex Regiment at age 18. He joined at Chichester. This info comes from the British Army WW1 Pension Records. It states his birth county as Sussex Parrish Sharrinton.

The following info may pertain to Jeremiah, but since O'Brien is common I can't say for sure if it is the same family line, but I'll add it anyway in case anyone else cares to investigate. It's from the 1891 census.

Jeremiah O'brien, moms name Mary O'brien. Jeremiah born Woolwich, London England. Civil Parrish Woolwich Ecclestical parrish Holy Trinity. He had a brother named James. Mary was born in 1841 in Ireland.

Again, this may or not be her paternal line, but Jeremiah was in the military. I've seen the original papers online.

I thought I would add that Tom Springfield was born Dionysius P. O'Brien. I'm not sure if the spelling is correct.

If I can find out more I'll post it. Another cousin of Dusty's posted on FB last year on Dusty's birthday. She is related to her on the maternal line. The common ancestor is Mary Lawlor, a grandma in Dusty's tree.
