It's been quite awhile since I commnted on Dusty's music, and I agree that there are several tearjerkers here. I like most of the ones that have been posted on the list. And I'd like to offer some of mine.

These are in no order of preference or ability to elicit the most tears out of me, but I do have some points I wanted to make about each.

- 1. Goin' Back this is the one that is guaranteed to bring the most tears out of me each time I listen to it. I think for me, the biggest reason this does so, besides the hauntingly beautiful lyrics and musical arrangement, is the fact that this song was the song Dusty herself chose as the theme song for her funeral. A part of me also thinks about William Whitehead, the guy who used to be on the original Dustymail, whom I was taking a real liking to before his murder. He had a major role in getting Dusty reinstated in South Africa, and I'll never forget the story he told me about how that came about when someone just put on a Dusty record one day, and nobody did anything about it. What a great guy he must have been. He, along with former Chicago guitarist Dawayne Bailey, are major reasons I'm a Dusty fan, and all of you are great reasons I will always lover her and her music.
- 2. What Are You Doing The Rest Of Your Life another great Dusty tearjerker, and another fave of mine. Bailey told me this was perhaps his personal favorite.
- 3. I Think It's Going To Rain Today what a very poignant song, and very hauntingly beautiful as well.
- 4. Poor Wayfaring Stranger I have this on video, and love it.
- 5. Quiet Please, There's A Lady On Stage from Dusty Springfield Live At The Royal Albert Hall I just love this one!
- 6. You Don't Have To Say You Love Me I think after Goin' Back, this is perhaps the ultimate Dusty tearjerker and the way she emotes herself is perhaps the biggest reason it was her highest-charting song all the way to number 1.

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- 7. All I See Is You another great one, that also brings a tear to my eyes.
- 8. I Don't Want To Hear it Anymore the subject matter, the lyrics, and the musical arrangements make this song about poverty a major tearjerker.
- 9. Come In For A Dream A tearjerker all right, but for the opposite reason not sad at all, but very hauntingly beautiful and happy. I also love the Latin polyrhythmic tone.
- 10. Some Of Your Lovin' This song doesn't make me sad, either. But it is so beautiful that it brings tears of joy to me.
- 11. 24 Hours From Tulsa her rendition of the Gene Pitney classic will bring out the tears in me every time.

Honorable mention: just about any of the Motown songs she covered were so good, and with my own personal remembrances of Motown - having lived not too far away, and how that music was so huge in the Flint area as well, brings back childhood memories. She did an excellent job on these, and became real good friends with most of the Motown singers. I'd love to visit the Motown Museum someday.
