

There's no significant discrepancy in the rankings of her biggest hits: **Cashbox** is more generous in its assessment of the impact of some of Dusty's moderate hits with *All Cried Out* afforded Top 40 status with a #31 peak, & *I'll Try Anything* and *Windmills of Your Mind* both significantly best their **Billboard** peaks at respectively #29 & #22. However to ally with **Cashbox** where Dusty is concerned would be a "win on the roundabout lose on the swings" situation as *Stay Awhile* failed to reach the **Cashbox** Top 40 at #42 & while the #22 peak afforded *Look of Love* by **Billboard** is universally considered a slight to one of her prime recordings it's significantly stronger than the track's **Cashbox** peak of #29. It's fun to review the chart positions for Dusty & other singers but to a

degree these chart positions are nothing but a number & often not a reliable measure of how much impact a recording had.
