According to the Mansion Global site Dusty's former Aubrey Walk residence "hit the market" Saturday with a £14 million asking price: if someone has purchased it since last summer when the asking price was £15.5 million they either negotiated a considerably lower price or they're prepared to take a comparatively small profit if not a loss.
