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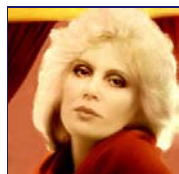

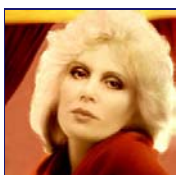

She belonged to several unions at a time when some musicians didn't and it would have been hard to reconcile what she saw in the working class north of England when she was on tour with conservative politics.
