I've recently purchased the 2004 "Classics & Collectibles" CD and was surprised to hear the different mixes on "In the Middle of Nowhere" and "Little By Little". I gather Little By Little on this CD is the

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hit 45 mix and that for some reason the 2006 "Complete A Sides & B Sides 1963-1970" CD uses a different mix, apparently a fold down, without some of the backing vocals found on the 45 mix.

"In the Middle of Nowhere" on the 2004 CD also has some very clear upfront horn parts that are buried and reverbed in the mix on the 2006 CD. I'd like to know if either of them is the 45 mix.

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
