Thank you ALL for your lovely comments! All the recent Photoshop & music stuff I've been doing has really become a "labor of love." I'm sure many of you who produce fan art feel the same way. I seem to have no end to my energy and motivation when it comes to honoring Dusty. But composition assignments? Stuff for work? Not so much. So it goes.

Linda: 😊 I still can't figure out how to turn off that automatic Continuous Play feature on Soundcloud, so yes, you heard my singer-songwriter stuff with me performing all the parts. I wrote everything except for Two Brothers, which I arranged for guitar & added some different harmonies.

Jeffery: Nick IS an oboist, but he only played bassoon on this. I did oboe & EH. He plays a million other wind instruments too. He's talented and MARKETABLE as a pit musician, orchestra sub, & private lesson teacher. We both majored in music composition and have played together in the Brooklyn Symphony Orchestra for 4 yrs. We both play EH, but he let me take Dusty's melody on this one. :) There's never been any animosity or competition between us because we're both very realistic about our strengths and weaknesses, and we compliment each other in those areas. We're already planning another Dusty cover that may involve our saxophones. Stay tuned - but first up: YOUR DUSTY PHOTO - VERY SOON, I PROMISE!

Cor: Oh I KNOW she would. You can get a lot of mileage out of band-geek innuendos and inside jokes. Hautbois (oboe) literally means "high wood". And I still smirk when I see the abbreviation "Fag." over bassoon cues in my part. What makes it funnier is that 90% of double-reed players I know are in the "not straight" category. Another thing: I know Dusty said that a lot of her producers in the 70s didn't even ask her what key she wanted to sing in, but this is in C# minor and, (you're a cellist, back me up) I HIGHLY doubt any instrumentalist would have chosen to play in C# minor! Why? Awkward fingering! It just doesn't lay well. So we joked that its no wonder the song is called Exclusively For Me. Not surprisingly, Donnez-moi allows for much easier fingering. The top part dominates the piece, but the bottom demands a lot of fast and light tonguing. Because of that, I think we'll make it very English horny. *smirk* 😏 Good God, am I going to be flagged, mods?

Maria: An English horn is kind of like a bass oboe. Same fingerings, but everything is bigger and sounds a fifth lower. It's in F, like French horn. Most oboe players double on EH at some point, although many don't own their own instrument. Some pieces have the 2nd or 3rd oboe switch back and forth, but the music is always transposed for the EH sections so you don't have to think about it.

* One more thing, I know this is a kind of depressing, melancholy song & I hesitated posting it for her birthday. But it's so pretty & plaintive that I figured it would be appropriate without the words & based on the title alone (Ironically, this "exclusive" song has more listens than anything else I've posted!) I'll admit, I still hear the words in my head. The first time I heard In The Winter, Home To Myself, & EFM in a row, I bawled my eyes out. But of the 3, I think this one is the least depressing, right?

it was really lovely. a very tender rendition of a lovely song and like Neil said, you could hear Dusty singing the vocal all through it.

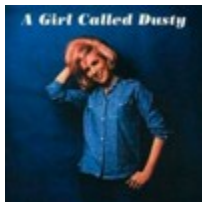
