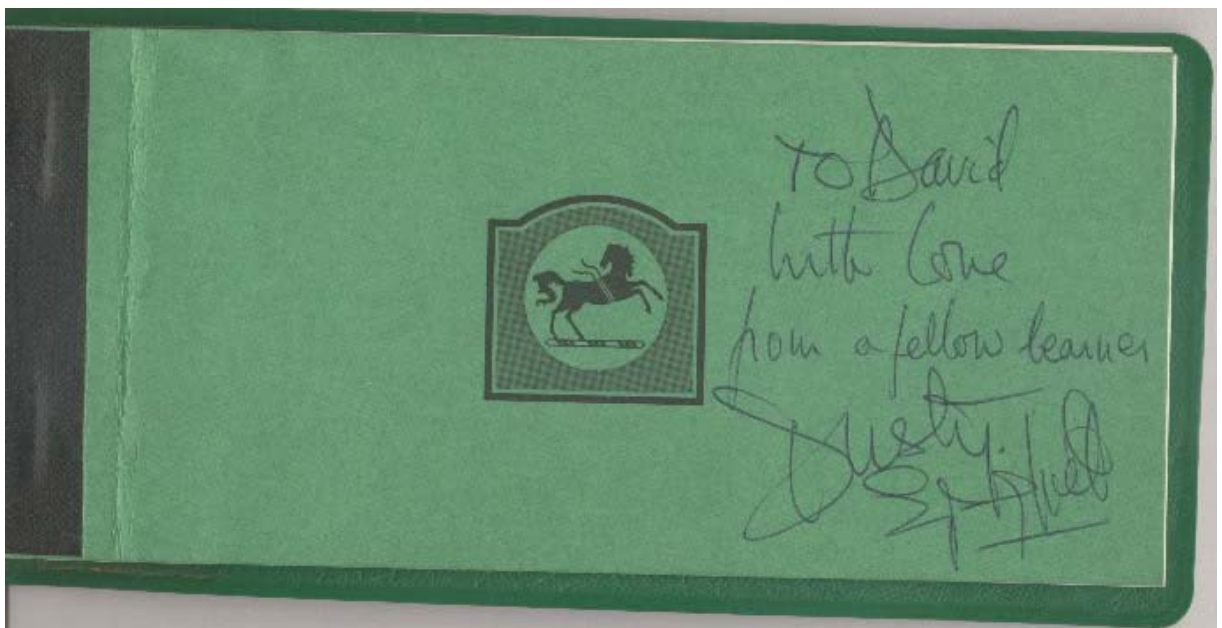
My friend, David, turned round to say hello to the previous pupil - and it was Dusty sitting on the back seat of the car!
