According to Paul Howes' book Dusty gave a number of UK TV performances of Goin' Back:

Tarbuck at the Prince of Wales - ITV 8 May 1966 Top of the Pops - BBC1 30 June 1966 Ready, Steady, Go - ITV 1 and 15 July 1966 Billy Cotton's Music Hall - BBC1 17 July 1966 Dusty - BBC1 25 August 1966

The TOTP performance of 30 June 1966 was included again in the edition of 14 July 1966. PH's book treats the TOTP performance as if Dusty had mimed to the record, but my memory is that she sang it live. The RSG dates are for two separate performances.

Despite her professed love for the song, she did not go back to it once the promotional period was over, apart from including it in a medley in the 1979 RAH concert.
