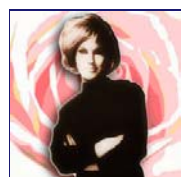

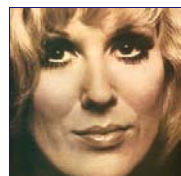
Also, the entire 'White Heat' album is a good one to turn up to 11 when you're in a mood.

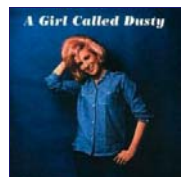

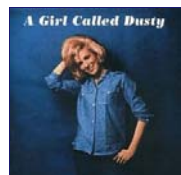

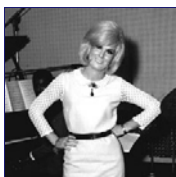
