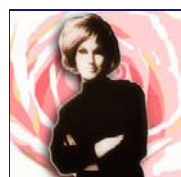

I still think this is one of Dusty's most vulnerable vocals, particularly the version on 'Classics And Collectibles'.

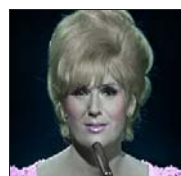
