Currently I think Universal own the rights to this 🤔🤔 and some other deleted Dusty albums and are reluctant to re-release while they still have Dusty Box-sets on Sale. 🙄

Hopefully it will be reissued again very soon, but I wouldn't hold your breath, 🙄 in the meantime I downloaded the Album, and bought the Vinyl version for £7. 🙄
