Today, Dusty would have been 77 years old, and most probably the 'grooviest' OAP in the country She meant so much to so many people, obviously for her amazing voice, her musicianship, dedication to her art and the pure 'knack' of recording some of the greatest songs ever written in popular music.

I am one of the lucky one's, as I was there from the beginning...listening to The Lana Sisters (still way ahead of the pack even back then), through to The Springfields who brought class and a lot of 'fun' to British music in the early 60's and IMO starting to change in some way the 'establishment' of stiff upper lip British broadcasting.

They grinned a lot, they had fun on stage, and they were 'jolly'but, the best was yet to come.

The early/mid 60's in England was an EXCITING place to be....things moved so fast and music was right up there.

There was more 'freedom' for young teenagers and they grabbed it with both hands. Coffee bars sprung up everywhere, little clubs where you could dance the night away, but for me it was always the music...mainly American music heard on Radio Luxembourg.....The Shirelles, Carole King, Neil Sedaka, The Marvelettes, Del Shannon, rock 'n' roll, rhythm & blues....it was all SO fresh.

We all know Dusty made the right decision to go 'solo' in '63, leaving the group who had been voted 'Best British Group' for 2 years running.....that voice NEEDED to be heard, We all know the story.

When people look back over the years at the history of music it will be clear that Dusty was a MAJOR force (if not THE MAJOR) force in shaping the 60's pop revolution. True we had the Merseybeat groups who were huge (especially for young girls), but we still had the more traditional 'singers' left over from the simple times of the 50's...Frankie Vaughan, Dickie Valentine, Rosemary Clooney, Perry Como, Petula Clark etc - all good singers, professional but slightly lacking in 'oomph'!

Dusty changed all that...her look, her dedication to bring to our ears the outstanding musicianship that was coming out of the USA.....she 'championed' Motown, soul music and especially little known wonderful singers no one had ever heard of.....but at the same time she was still 'Dusty'....a woman who knew what she wanted.

The real love affair had begun and speaking for myself it has lasted forever....she means so much to me - she changed my life so much and made me appreciate so much more musically.

Some say you should always look forward and never back, but to live through this period of time along with Dusty was so very special - we really were born at the right time (apologies to anyone under 45!).

So, I've ranted on as usual, but I needed to say it.

So - today LET'S CELEBRATE.....THE GREATEST






