Don't know how many of you outside the States are familiar with my childhood hero, Mickey Mantle. He was a N.Y Yankees outfielder in the fifties and sixties. If not for a devastating first year knee injury, he quite possibly would have been the greatest baseball player ever. A tragic hero, he was the most celebrated American athlete of his era. At a spring golf tournament in 1969, the year after he retired, he heard the song performed by his good friend, Country-Western singer Roy Clark, who made the song a huge hit. The song actually made Mickey cry, and he made Clark promise to sing the song at his funeral. When Mick died in 1995, Clark made good on his promise and sang the song at the funeral.
