Segments of the interview were slotted in between the songs.

The whole show was made available to members of the Dusty Springfield Bulletin in 1991 as part of a videotape which also included UK TV appearances by The Springfields (One Note Samba and Island of Dreams) and Dusty (Nothing Rhymed, Take Me To The Pilot, The Look of Love, Meditation). All six of these songs are performed live.

It is a long time since I looked at the tape, but I think that the credits of Justy Dusty were rolled while Packin' Up was being performed. While some of the performances from the Dutch TV show have been included in DVD compilations, I assume one of the reasons Packin' Up has not appeared, and is probably unlikely to appear, is the fact that Dusty's appearance was partially obscured by the

programme's credits.

The tape was labelled 'ITC Video Tape - Volume 2'. I do not recall having seen it come up for sale on ebay in the UK over the last few years. That said, Kyle, I don't know how interested you would be in a PAL VHS videotape, given your location.
