It was Keith Fordyce who introduced Dusty at the 1966 NME Pollwinners' Concert. Fordyce was a radio DJ in the UK as well as the original presenter of the TV show Ready, Steady, Go! At that time almost all the UK DJs were, or so it seemed to me, middle-aged. The young DJs from the 'pirate' stations did not come onshore until 1967, when BBC radio was re-organised and BBC Radio 1 was launched.
