After a little detective work on the internet I now know that the TV show was British Ready, Steady, Go!, and the year probably 1963. In the same programme, Helen Shapiro (Walking back to happiness) and Eden Kane (Well I ask you) appeared. Dusty Springfield died in 1999, aged 59.

That letter to the editor does indeed sound exactly like something I could have written, but it wasn't me! 🐨 I'm pleased to note, though, that my view is shared by others.


That reminds me of 2 instances when Dusty pretended not to know who the Beatles were.






