

statue. There is another Springfields photo taken in the entrance to the small $\mbox{\sc b}/\mbox{\sc w}$ building in the background.



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



It's approx 3 miles from Henley-on-Thames in the village of HURLEY on the A4130 road towards Maidenhead. Travelling from the Henley direction take the turning left AFTER The Black Boy public house and follow the road down towards the river. After a short distance you'll arrive at a cross-roads with caravans in front of you - here turn left and Frogmill is a matter of yards.

As a matter of interest properties here range from £1,441 000 to £2, 035 000 - the last house sold there was in 2009 which sold for £1,700 000 - it looks as though it's a place people like to be!
