The 2001 US mixes were originally issued in the States in 2001 by Hip-O, a Universal subsidiary, as part of the CD Beautiful Soul - The ABC/Dunhill Collection, which brought together the tracks of the Cameo album with the nine tracks recorded for Longing. The three UK mixes were included in the Simply Dusty boxed set in 2000.

The Hip-O CD is on sale on Amazon UK for prices between £73 and £254. On Amazon US the prices range from \$64 and \$262. These figures do not include any typing errors!

Groove shark is gone. Did anyone get this. Is it the same mixes on the 2001 release I've owned that for years. Is it any different. I have other mixes of the songs through other sources I found. But on the 2001 release they were remixed from the multi track. I believe that was due to because they only made test mixes of it. Since the album was shelved and Dusty didn't make a album till 1978. Longing I think was her great last masterpiece. The 1970's even the 1980's also were a difficult time for Dusty. Looking back I think the competition that arose in the 1970's this was too hard for Dusty that she was struggling with her confidence. Because she owned the 1960's.

Was Longing supposed to be on ABC records or did she not have a label and just recorded that in NYC and just stopped after a while. As legend is told Bruce Springsteen was recording Born to Run at the same studio and would be listening to her record the album. I think that's true but Bruce was in a worried state himself if Born to Run didn't work out he would of lost his Columbia record contract. The documentary shows this in full detail his troubled state throughout.

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
