It's a pity they didn't include the original mixes on this download EP. For some reason, Universal have done better by the Supremes - they've also just put out the trio's Xmas album in an expanded edition download. You get the original mono album with alternate vocals on some tracks, solo Diana on the first two tracks - and then the stereo album with its unique mix and different/added parts. There's also some bonus tracks not included on the original album like Florence Ballard solos.

So why no similarly comprehensive treatment for Dusty? If they could remix the Mademoiselle Dusty tracks to stereo in the 90s, doesn't that mean that they have the original multitracks? Were the original mixes lost or purged from the archive as was popular with some labels from the 70s onward?

I think it's a bit of a crime that so many of Dusty's original mixes - the ones she actually worked on and approved - are unavailable digitally or on CD.

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
