Unlike other plays and musicals where someone is playing the part of Dusty, in this the writer/performer (Stephanie Ridings) is playing the part of the daughter Mary whose mother was the Dusty fan. They had a difficult relationship but the mother worshiped Dusty and was in fact, a Dusty tribute act. This led to what we see in the short play, Mary getting ready for the ash scattering ceremony, telling her story, having imaginary dialogue with her mother, and leading up to the finale where she don's her mothers Dusty dress and wig and stands in the spotlight and sings YDHTSYLM, which was her mothers last wish. It's a black comedy with a very northern feel to it. Steph had added to the script since the last time I saw it and there was a funny moment when I heard my words coming out of her mouth! There is a fair scattering of Dusty music coming from the record player and Dusty's quotes and lyrics are sprinkled around as well. I actually got a lump in my throat a couple of times, which considering this is a basic play in a small theatre with a minimal set, is

all credit to Steph. She also gets credit for applying false eyelashes with one hand whilst remembering her lines!

We had a chat later and she

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admitted offering up a "please" to Dusty before the show 🙂
