The Mum was called Christine Cann and it seems that she attended St Annes at the same time as Dusty, altho' Dusty was a little younger.

Anyway, I liked it and thought I'd share.



Christine: "I'm in the group under the Portico. St Anne's Convent [was] in Little Ealing Lane, Northfields, opposite a pub - I think it was called the 'Dick Turpin'. There was a tunnel from the school (previously a private house) to the pub which Dick Turpin was said to have used."

Celia: "[Christine's] expertise on the piano increased & increased, & once a year on the occasion of the headmistress's (Sr Stanislaus) feast day, she would play for all the school - probably much appreciated by the nuns & teachers, as she would have been preceded by Dusty Springfield & her guitar - who was in the class below!"

I always remember my mother mentioning that she was at school with the great Dusty Springfield - who at that time of course was still plain Mary O'Brien. This interesting revelation from Margaret about the annual concert gives rise to my mother having a kind of 'claim to fame'... she being 'top of the bill', with Dusty as her support act!

In 1986 this school undertook a radical change - becoming the 'King Fahad Academy' (which itself relocated in 2005). The buildings sadly now stand empty... behind heavy security gates, as I found when I paid a little visit in 2006!
