In 1971, Atlantic Records released a pair of Dusty Springfield singles produced by the legendary songwriter/producer Jeff Barry (one-time songwriting and romantic partner of Ellie Greenwich, and

author of too many hits to name): "Haunted"/"Nothing Is Forever" and "I Believe In You"/"Someone Who Cares." A restless Dusty, freshly relocating to America from her native England, then departed the label and left an additional 9 songs recorded with Barry in the can, where they stayed until Rhino issued one track, "Faithful" (in mono), as a bonus track on the 1990s CD release of Dusty's 1970 Atlantic album A Brand New Me. The other tracks didn't surface until a subsequent deluxe reissue of Dusty's landmark 1969 album Dusty in Memphis included them as bonus cuts. Now, reissue producer Jim Pierson—who tracked down the missing masters after being lost for over two decades—has assembled all of Dusty's Barry-produced masters and put them together in a single package for the first time to create the third Dusty Springfield Atlantic Records album as planned in 1971. Real Gone Music's release of Faithful presents these historic Barry-Springfield collaborations exactly as they were originally intended to be heard, with the 12 tracks intended for the album release and one intended for single-only release. All tracks are in stereo, while the liner notes, penned by The Second Disc's Joe Marchese, feature a number of rarely-seen photos of the legendary singer. These stunning pop, soul and gospel flavored selections showcase the iconic singer at the height of her vocal magic. A missing/jumbled part of Dusty's august recorded legacy, finally set right!

It seems to be generally held that Atlantic erased Dusty's vocal off the master of Sweet Charlie Babe with the track then being utilized for Jackie Moore's 1973 recording. However I have seen an online post which I can't find now from someone - I suspect Bobby Eli - who stated he'd worked on the Sigma sessions for both Dusty & Jackie & that in fact a new backing track was prepped for Jackie's recording of SCB. So Dusty's SCB may be somewhere out there altho if it hasn't surfaced by now IMHO it's unlikely ever to.

I'm glad the Faithful tracks are getting a re-release. It's probably my most played Dusty album after Memphis and the first two (British) LPs. But I think 13 tracks is a bit on the skimpy side for a reissue and to leave off "What Good Is I Love You" is a mistake. It dates from the same era and fits well with the other tracks. They could have easily added the singles tracks in their mono versions as bonus tracks - I've always thought that "What Good Is I Love You" would have had an extra kick in its mono version, but I haven't heard it. If they could release all the mono single version on the 2002 Memphis reissue, why not here? Those of us who like to listen to A-/B-Sides playlists appreciate having the mono tracks for that authentic "radio" experience.

Dusty Springfield Faithful (Real Gone) 3.5 out of 5 stars

Had these songs been released in late 1971, when they were originally scheduled, the dozen tracks would have been Dusty Springfield's third Atlantic album. Coming on the heels of 1969's successful Dusty in Memphis and 1970's A Brand New Me, the songwriter/producer Jeff Barry helmed tracks would have made for a pretty great trilogy. But that never happened.

Springfield decamped for ABC Dunhill leaving these songs in the vaults where they were thought to have vanished or even burned in a fire. Rhino released four on their expanded edition of Dusty In Memphis, but the rest stayed hidden away...until now. Reissue label Real Gone found the missing tunes and sequenced them along with an extra single to recreate the missing album, named after the key word in its opening tune "I'll Be Faithful."

While there is no "Son of a Preacher Man" here, a few tracks such as the funky "Haunted" and the surprisingly raw and rocking "Natchez Trace" come pretty close. Faithful follows the ... Memphis blueprint of recording a Southern soul set in New York City, only without a band that captured a swampy groove as effectively. The musician credits are frustratingly MIA (perhaps they were also misplaced), but the group does an admirable job of laying down these songs and allowing plenty of room for Dusty to take control.

The singer was arguably at the peak of her talents during these sessions. Here she smothers her husky pipes over the gospel pop of "I Found My Way Through the Darkness" and the more laid back, but no less heartfelt, Bread cover "Make it With You" complete with orchestration. Perhaps the Burt Bacharach-styled dynamic ballad "Love Shine Down" and Barry's passionate "I Believe in You" would even have been hits if given a chance when they were recorded almost 45 years ago.

We'll never know but it's a treat to have this music that few fans even knew existed, available. Real Gone packages it professionally with informative liner notes that fill in some missing pieces of the story and classy photos from the era. The audio is clean and well mastered. Dusty is in terrific

voice and spirits making this something of a lost, and now found, classic.


