Hi everyone, how you all doing? I like the new site -Teal looks a bit last year now, LOL.

Have been busy over last few months in the music studio learning new equipment. Over Xmas I thought I would play at remixing Dusty...In the end I sampled a bit of 'Windmills' - but I couldn't bring myself to chop up Dusty's vocals for - as we all know she would have gone totally mad at me for being so disrespectful... LOL...So I wrote a new piece of music around some of the instrumentation at the end of Windmills.

If/when you hear it - you will of course recognise what I've borrowed - as you all know Memphis so well.

I have contacted Atlantic to ask them how I go about get official permission to sample as I'm pleased enough with the track to want to publish it. Not really expecting approval though or if so probably a large fee will have to change hands....

Anyway I don't feel I'd better post it until I know where I stand, but thought you might be interested in the back story. It felt really odd (but amazing) to have Dusty singing with my music - even if I didn't in the end use her voice - and it raised my game a bit I think. Great fun.

I will post it when possible. In the US sampling permission is easier as there is something called 'fair use', however in the UK the law is a bit stricter so I had better play safe as I am bringing music into my day job this year - thus making professional use of samples etc.

It seemed sensible to bring my music into my day job as an artist- if I work it right my music equipment must surely be tax deductable ...
