Nicole Kidman will star in a big Hollywood musical called Nine, due to start shooting in London in October

Nicole Kidman, Penelope Cruz and Marion Cotillard will be pulling on their leotards for dance practice when they arrive in London to star in a big Hollywood musical.

The award-winning actresses will be joining Judi Dench and Sophia Loren (although I somehow feel those two stars don't rehearse in a leotards these days).

They all play the numerous women in the life of a top film director going through a personal and professional crisis. It's based on Federico Fellini's classic 1963 film 81/2.

Anthony Minghella wrote a draft of the screenplay before he died. The director will be played by Daniel Day-Lewis, and the film is called Nine.

It will be shot at Shepperton Studios for five months starting in October, although many of the stars may fly into town in September to prepare for the project, backed by Harvey Weinstein's The Weinstein Company.

It's a major boost for British-based hair and make-up designers, technicians, carpenters and other crew members.

Nine is being directed and choreographed by Rob Marshall, who made the Oscar-winning movie Chicago.
