Many years ago Nirvana was on MTV unplugged and did, in my opinion, a chilling acoustic version of the Leadbelly song "Where Did You Sleep Last Night." There is a song on Norma's first LP called "Hey Girl" and it's the same song. It's played as a slow blues with nice acoustic guitar a harmonica and sounds VERY much like the Nirvana arrangement of the song. I know Kurt Cobain's family was supposed to have played lots of different music for Kurt when he was a kid. I wonder if he might have heard Norma's record? Just a thought. Here's a useless piece of trivia. The guy that plays harmonica on Norma's album also played harp on Laura Nyro's version of her song "Wedding Bell Blues."

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


