Hi Rich, I presume you are referring to the programme on Sky Arts. The programme they show is the DVD Once Upon a Time 1964-69 as part of the British Invasion series made by ITV, which includes Gerry and The Pacemakers etc. This series is often repeated. The comments about miming is difficult as in the early days it was allowed and there are several songs which I would say she is miming to, especially the Australian Bandstand. IMO I don't think Dusty was happy miming but much preferred singing to the orchestrated track, but maybe that facility was not available in the early days. Dusty wanted fans to hear her as on her records so this was a compromise as to hire an orchestra or group would have been very expensive and time consuming.

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
