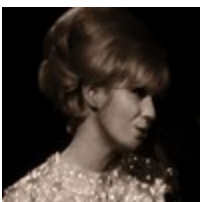

I am the youngest of three. I had two older brothers. On November 23, 2011, the younger of my two brothers died after a two-year battle with Mesothelioma lung cancer. This is the same cancer that killed my father 20 years ago. Nat worked at the plant with Daddy for 6 months when he was 18 years old. He passed at age 55. Not three months later on February 18, 2012, we found my oldest brother dead in his home. Possible massive heart attack. Rough time for me. Still not over it completely. I DO believe in the Hereafter.

When Nat (younger brother) got sick, he knew he wasn't going to make it, and started making preparations. He and my sister in law had a conversation and developed a sign that he would provide to her, to assure her he was still around. They didnt tell anyone what the "sign" was. When he died, I was on my way across the Mississippi River to his funeral. Nat was a BIG Pink Floyd fan, similar to my obsession with Dusty. The radio station I listen to in the car NEVER played any Pink Floyd. All of a sudden, here is Pink Floyd's "Wish You Were Here". I smiled to myself, and thought Ok. I know you're here. Right after that, I had this feeling like someone was pushing on my shoulder. Then this voice "Tell her I'm here! Tell her I'm here!". I was taken aback, of course, and it continued and got more insistent. "Tell her I'm here! Tell her! Tell her!" Not until I said out loud, "Ok OK I'll tell her!" did it stop. After the funeral, I kept my promise, I did tell my sister in law what transpired.

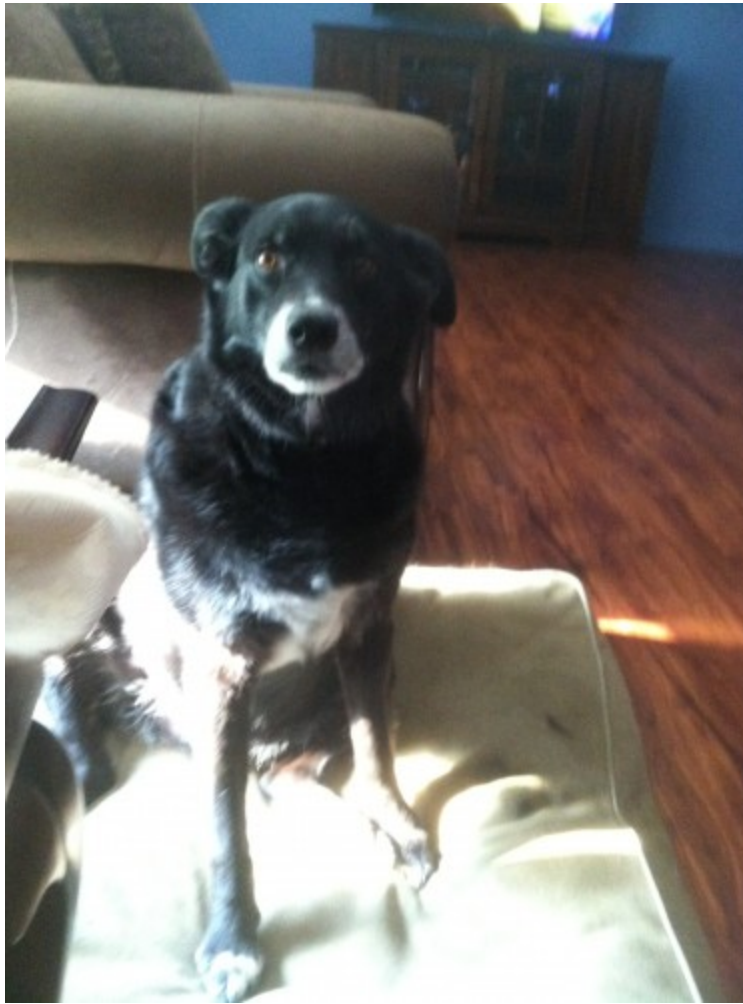
My sister in law and my nieces recently had a reading with the medium, John Edward. I was supposed to go with them, but had a gallbladder attack after eating some Popeye's Fried Chicken. I did not tell them until afterward that it was the chicken that gave me the attack. My brother Nat LOVED Popeye's chicken. Sister in law finally told us, that was the "sign". Popeyes!

Often, now, I will get a "spiritual" feeling, and sure enough, the same Pink Floyd song "Wish You Were Here" will come on, and I know my brother is with me.

As for my older brother, he lived with me for a few years since his home was flooded during Hurricane Katrina. He was very fond of my 7 year old Border Collie, Elvis. Sometimes I catch Elvis staring into the corner of the room by the ceiling. I ask him, who's that? Uncle B? And he wags his tail.

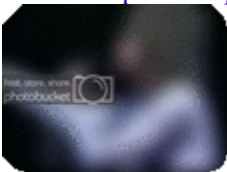

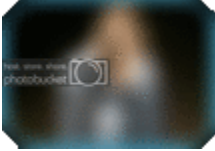

Amanda asked him if she talked to him and he said yes, she sits on my bed before I go to sleep and we talk.

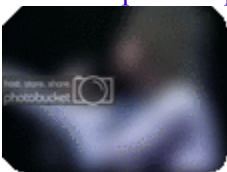

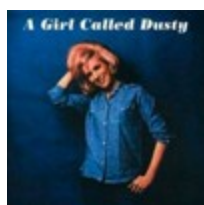
I must just say that after 42 years nursing, most of them spent in either Coronary care, cardiac surgery and critical care/intensive care units, I am not convinced about these experiences being a glimpse into the "next life" I never witnessed a patient "brought back to life" say they had any of these experiences and yet was proactive many many times when pts survived cardiac arrests or awoke after being on ventilatory support. we did get pts who had nightmarish dreams but not relating to thinking they had died or were floating above the bed etc. nor pts who had seen relatives coming for them. we did often see pts who were dying having conversations with invisible (to us) people and often calling out to them.

these same pts often smile into the space around them as if they are seeing something and are calm about it so maybe they can see someone we cant. I do believe that often people who are dying seem aware that we are with them and talking to them and that's a great comfort for us, whether true or not. I know my Mother "saw " my Father a few times in the last few years before she died. I also think that there is such a different feel to a room when a pt dies ,as if the soul really has left the body and I always felt it being in a room with someone who had just passed. when I trained we were taught to perform the "last offices or laying out " and part of this procedure (which was performed by two nurses in silence as a mark of respect) was to open the window in the room to allow the soul to leave the room. all this ritual was very important then, how times have changed, as none of this is really continued today. I think and of course hope that there is an afterlife but some of these books don't do it for me. I do believe that conscious people see supernatural things and I certainly cant explain that. its such a fleeting time we spend on this earth and there is the never ending question we all have about the point of being here so I believe there is more to us than our time here. one day we will know. "every day I find you're in my heart and on my mind"
