I am somewhat thrown by your statement: "First, this IS NOT an upcoming Broadway production" as there's been no evident claim otherwise, certainly not in my opening post which speaks of "the upcoming off-Broadway production **All Her Faces**". I thought perhaps you'd seen info at [allherfaces.com](#) or in the blurb accompanying the preview clip which you deemed unclear: however for me [allherfaces.com](#) clearly defines the production's aim as being an off-Broadway run in the fall, & there's no comments attached to the preview clip about any anticipated Broadway engagement.

Ultimately I would like anything with Dusty's name attached to it to be as meritorious as possible: certainly I hope no Dusty fan ends up walking out of this edition of **All Her Faces** feeling hatred for the production. However I'm not at all touting **All Her Faces** as a production of whatever professional level. I happened to come across the production's preview clip on Youtube & as the LDT webmasters had already deemed the basic info on **All Her Faces** worthy of mention on this site's homepage I thought some of my board bud's might be interested in seeing the preview clip. I personally find the clip interesting enough for what it evidently is: I don't find the clip evokes the production strongly enough to draw from me either a positive or negative reaction.

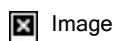
