No she didn't Will got a mail describing the dress they had found, and the dress from the Tom Jones Show was the one that immediately entered my head. I doubt they really expected to get a match so easily and good that we could help. Although Dusty had a lot of dresses made for her by Darnell, she also used to "borrow" from the costume departments of the TV companies, which is likely what happened with this dress. It's possible that designers also loaned them to her as well. For instance, the outfit she wore on the Shirley Bassey Show when she sang I'm Coming Home Again and Save Me, Save Me, was loaned from Ossie Clark. It's nice to think that this dress will now be displayed, rather than just hanging limply on a rack





Thanks for the great picture.

Just to let the members for the LTD forum know that we are currently restoring the neck of the dress.

When we found the dress the thread stitching the braid to the neck had rotten, meaning it wasn't securely held on. I have carefully removed the perished cotton and am currently in the process of restoring the braid as per the 1971 appearances.

We'll re-send a picture once the dress is back to it's former glory.






