Belated sad news: www.genyaravan.com the official site of Genya Ravan aka Goldie of the Gingerbreads has reported the March 12 passing of Carol MacDonald. Besides being the guitarist for the pioneer femrock band the Gingerbreads Carol was the frontwoman for the 70s funk-rock female ensemble Isis & as such was one of the first openly gay recording artists. In 1965 Carol along with Gingerbreads drummer Margo Lewis & pioneer female disc jockey Stevie Holly took a flat at 85 Westbourne Terrace in Westminster: the three women's friendship with Dusty precipitated Dusty herself renting a flat in the building where Madeline Bell was also a sometime tenant. Reportedly Carol & Margo also performed backing vocals for Dusty.

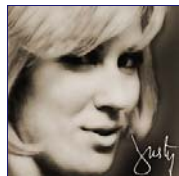
